How to Use Rural Nebraska Public Transportation

Need to book a ride? We can help!

Step 1:

Find your local transit provider's phone number listed at the right. (We've listed the numbers by county).

Step 2:

Call the transit provider in your service area.

Step 3:

Let the dispatcher know where you are going and when you need to be there. (Please note: it is best to call 2-3 days in advance. Same-day service is not available in all areas.)

The dispatcher will schedule your trip, confirm pick-up/drop-off times, and let you know the cost.

Local transit service is offered at reasonable rates and can help get you where you need to be. It's both convenient and cost-effective. **Get on Board!**

Did you know?

Across Nebraska, rural public transit is taking people where they need to go. In 2014, the state's rural transit drivers provided more than 650,000 trips and traveled almost 3 million miles. Thousands of Cornhuskers are using rural public transit as a safe, reliable, cost-effective way to travel.

Most rural transit providers offer demand-response transportation. That means you can just phone in for a ride! Your local transit provider will pick you up, take you where you need to go, and then take you back home again.
