Our private, non-profit agency serves 27 counties in south central Nebraska. 2025 was another busy year of providing quality program services to meet the greatest needs in our communities.

**Our agency employs 242 staff, and our 2025 budget was over \$15 million dollars.**

We are proud of the work we do that truly enables us to *Help People and Change Lives.*

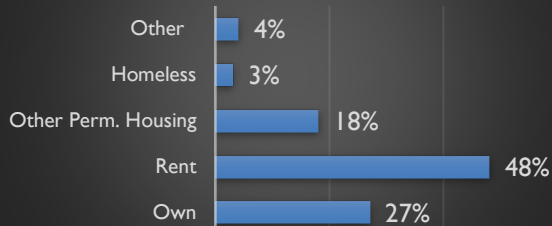
# Community Action Changes Lives

**Last year the agency served 13,827 individuals.**

**Family:** 53% of individuals served were Single Persons, 15% were Two-Parent Households 14% were Single-Parent Females, 11% were Two Adults with No Dependents, 5% were Other Household Types and 2% were Single Parent Males.

**Ethnicity / Race:** 60% were White, 18% were Hispanic/Latino, 17% were Multi-race, 3% were African American, and 2% were American Indian, Asian, Pacific Islander, or Native American.

## Housing Types

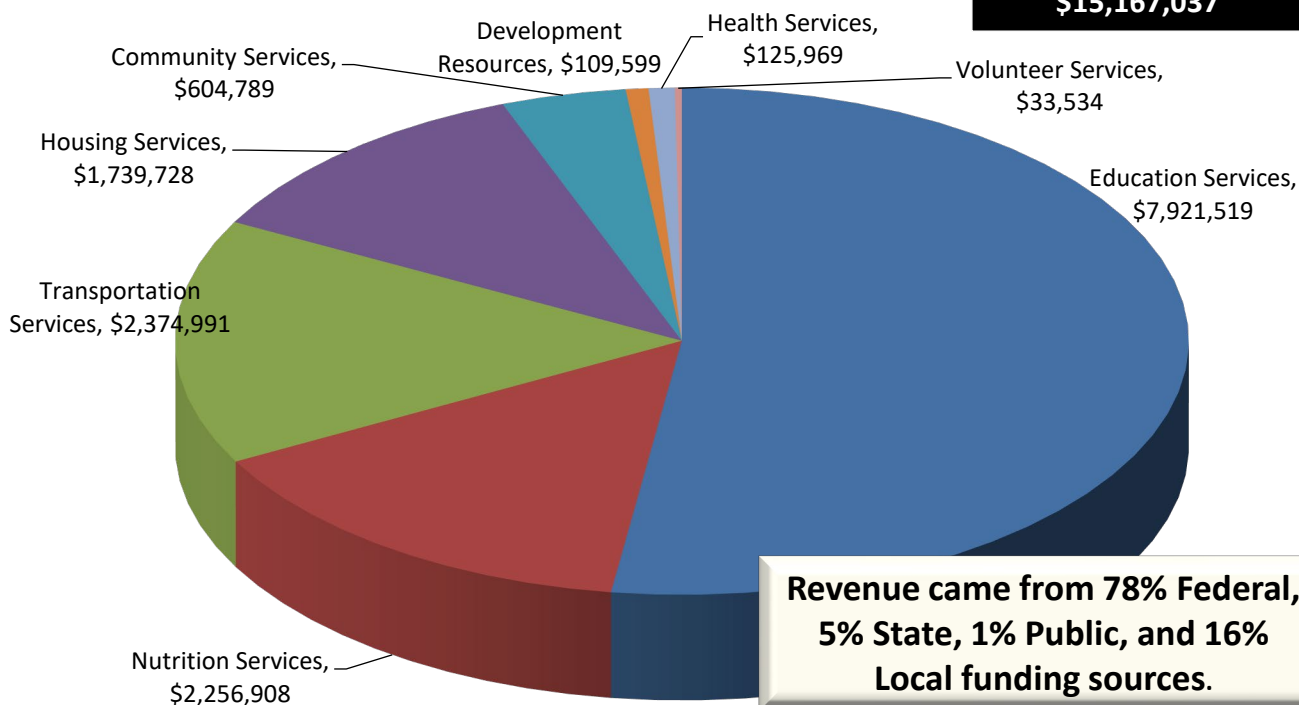


76% of clients served fell below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level. For a single person, this means they are making less than \$1,304 per month.

**Revenue came from 78% Federal, 5% State, 1% Public, and 16% Local funding sources.**

# Community Impact



Community volunteers donated **124,629** hours to agency programs.

We partnered with over **640** organizations to help expand resources and opportunities to improve family and community outcomes.

**Six** local United Ways helped support **8** different Community Action programs.

# Year In Review



286 children demonstrated improved skills for school readiness.



WIC served 4,508 clients with nutritional needs.

Our Mobile Pantries distributed 75,512 pounds of food.

2,938 Seniors maintained their independent living through our Commodity Supplemental Food Program, Senior Volunteer Program, and Senior Centers.



## Housing and Emergency Assistance



- 176 individuals obtained safe and affordable housing.
- 511 individuals were assisted to prevent eviction.
- 581 households received financial skills training.
- 38 homes were completed through the Weatherization Program.



RYDE Transit provided 78,839 total boardings serving seven counties.

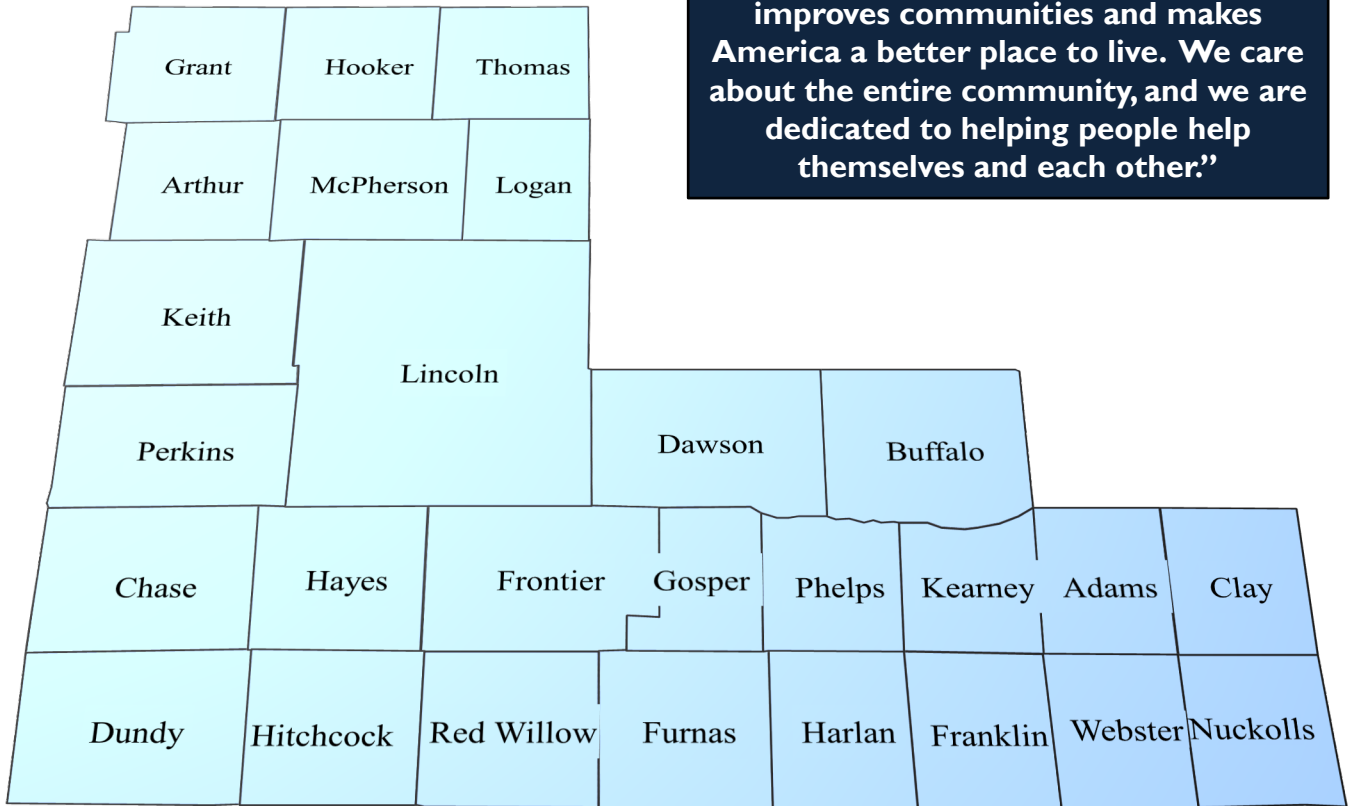


615 youth immunizations were administered through our Health Service Program.
